### CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS

**30+ days before camp start date** → No refund, credit to student's account towards future classes.

**30 days or less before camp start date** → No refund or credit for any reason, including medical.  
No refunds or makeups for missed days.

### DISCOUNTS

**Early payment discount:** 5% off when you prepay in full before May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026

**Sibling discount:** 5% off the full week(s) tuition for 2<sup>nd</sup> child, when you have siblings enrolled into full week camp

**Multiple weeks:** 5% off when you register and prepay in full for 5 full weeks of camp.



## Welcome to Ace Gymnastics Academy Summer Program!

The Summer Rhythmic Gymnastics Camp at Ace Gymnastics Academy is designed for girls of all experience levels—from complete beginners to competitive gymnasts (Xcel, Level 3-8, FIG), ages 5 and up.

Beginners will learn new rhythmic gymnastics skills with rope, hoop, ball and ribbon, improve flexibility, get stronger, learn new acrobatic skills and, of course, have lots of fun!

Competitive athletes and those who want to join the team for 2026-2027 season will be working on improving and advancing body difficulties and apparatus skills. All competition routines will be choreographed during Summer Camp as well (separate fee). Competitive season starts with the Summer Camp training, and skills acquired during Summer Camp will be imperative for a successful season.

All campers will be divided into groups based on the age and skill level, ensuring instruction is both age-appropriate and aligned with each gymnast's preparation level, all within a supportive and energetic environment.

We have implemented several Policies to assure that the summer training is productive, fun and safe for all the participants.

### Dress Code

Solid black leotard/tank top, stretchy shorts, white socks/toe-shoes. Hair must be in a bun or a short ponytail. No jewelry allowed (small stud earrings are okay).

### Drop Off and Pick Up

We ask that parents physically come into the sports complex to drop off and pick up their children regardless of age, and sign them in at the iPad station. Camp starts and ends at the scheduled times. Please be sure you see your child in class prior to leaving the facility and pick her up on time. We are unable to supervise children prior or post camp/class time. Ace Gymnastics staff is responsible for children only during their scheduled camp times. If you need to pick up your child early, please let us know at the time of drop-off.

### Attendance

Please notify the gym via text message (424-999-9655) or email (info@acegymacademy.com) if your child is going to miss a camp day prior to practice time. In case of an illness, please let us know asap and keep a sick child at home!

### Code of conduct

Your children are our priority and we hold primary responsibility for maintaining safe environment during camp for all the participants. Child may be asked to leave camp after several disciplinary warnings. This may include disruptive or dangerous behavior, being rude or disrespectful to the coach or other campers.

### Questions/Concerns

If you need to speak to your child's coach, please do so after the class. We are happy to answer any questions you might have regarding your child or the program. We are asking not to call/text coaches during the camp training, unless it is an absolute emergency. Harassing or threatening a coach in any way will cause an immediate dismissal from the Program and the Academy.

### Parents Responsibilities

Please make sure all contact information is current and up to date, and all payments are made on time!

### What to bring

Please make sure your child has enough fresh water for the day. No glass bottles are allowed at the gym.



## Competition Team Summer Camp Policies

For team athletes and prospective team members for 2026-27 competition season, the season starts on July 7th with Camp training. All level placements are based on Summer Camp attendance and performance as well as August practice, and will be finalized by September 5th, 2026.

### **Team gymnasts must have available at every practice**

- All apparatus appropriate to their age/level (rope, hoop, ball, clubs, ribbon)
- Thera-band
- Pastorelli band with loops/numbers (pink)
- Two tennis balls
- Water bottle

### **Summer Camp attendance**

We strongly encourage all our current and prospective competitive gymnasts to sign up for the entire duration of the Summer Camp.

### **Routines Choreography**

All competition routines for new season will be choreographed during the summer camp.

Routines choreography fees are not included into Summer Camp tuition, are a separate charge and depend on the athlete's level:

Xcel Copper/Bronze (2 routines): \$75 per gymnast

Xcel Silver (3 routines): \$125 per gymnast

Xcel Gold (3 routines): \$150 per gymnast

Xcel Diamond/Platinum (3 routines): \$200 per gymnast

Level 3 (all routines): \$100 per gymnast

Level 4 (all routines): \$150 per gymnast

Level 5 (all routines): \$200 per gymnast

Level 6 (all routines): \$400 per gymnast

Level 7-8: \$400 per routine per gymnast, \$500 per routine if shared between 2 gymnasts

FIG: \$600 per routine

If redoing the gymnast's routine with the Code of Points updates within the same level – 50% off the original routine choreography
